



#### Tim and Gwendy Colwell-Missionaries to the Yukon Territory in Canada

Tim and Gwendy minister to the Kaska First Nation in Ross River, Yukon Territory, Canada. The Colwells seek to reach the lost in Ross River through visitation, one-on-one discipleship, Kids' Bible Club and Bible camps, adult Bible studies and weekly meetings. They also operate the HOPE Centre, a 3,600 square-foot multi-purpose ministry center where people from their community can come and have a safe place to gather and find the HOPE that only comes from knowing Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior.

They joined SEND twenty-five years ago with the purpose of seeing a vibrant, Christ-centered church established in Ross River. They committed to serving the Lord as long as He had a desire for them to serve Him in the small community of Ross River which has included some hard times as they helped others draw closer to the Lord.

The Colwells are looking forward to holding Kamp Klondike (a camp for kids) this summer after two years of being shut down by COVID. Your prayers for their continuation of Bible studies and clubs are most appreciated.
