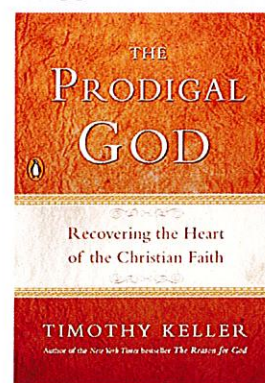

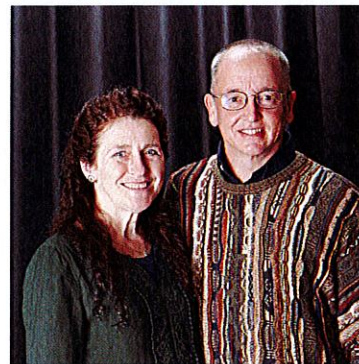
COME JOIN US!
