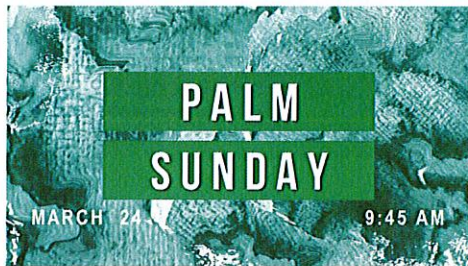

We have been and will continue to be reminded that there is a great promise in the Gospel, this Good News that *"...is the power of God for the salvation of everyone who believes...For in the gospel a righteousness from God is revealed, a righteousness that is by faith from first to last, just as it is written: 'The righteous will live by faith.'"* Romans 1:16-17

Large groups of young Native Americans have given up hope on life, drowning their pain in alcohol or drugs. Resulting heartbreak has intensified their resolve to plant the hope of God's Word into the lives of young people during June's camping season.

Joe writes, "It's that time of year to advertise project needs. If you would be interested in helping, we have metal roofing to be installed, dorm porches to be resurfaced, and painting to be done. We could also use a camp cleanup crew. The dates can range from Mid-March into May. Please contact us if you or your church would be interested in any of these projects.
