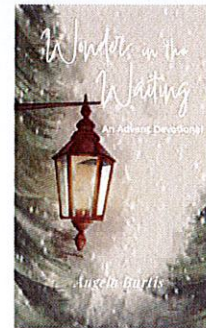
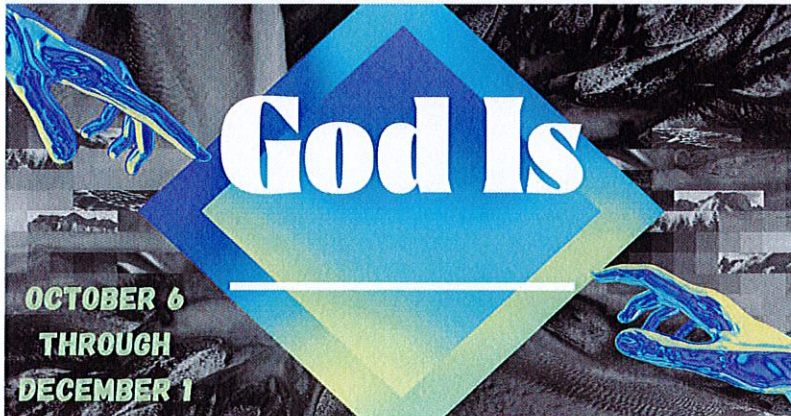

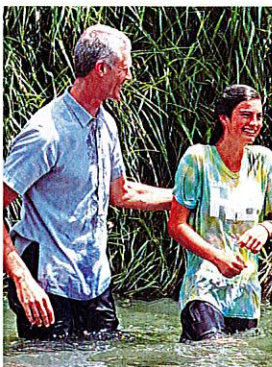


Christopher & Darlene Clark **Missionaries to Papua New Guinea**
